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END OF LIFE AND AFTERCARE SERVICES DEFINITIONS

Euthanasia - The humane ending of an animal’s life by injection.

Communal Cremation – Once the animal has passed on, his or her body is cremated along with other animals; ashes are comingled with those of other cremated animals and, then, sprinkled out in nature. Ashes are not returned to the owner.

Individual Cremation - Once the animal has passed on, his or her body is cremated alongside --- *but individually partitioned and separated from* --- 3-5 other animals. Each animal in this shared space is individually identified so that the owner receives only the ashes of his or her animal; ashes are not comingled.

Deceased on Arrival/Communal Cremation – An animal, who has already passed on, is brought in and a communal cremation is requested (see “communal cremation” above)

Deceased on Arrival/Individual Cremation – An animal, who has already passed on, is brought in and an individual cremation is requested (see “individual cremation” above)

Euthanasia Unattended by Owner/Pet Returned to Owner - An animal is dropped off, by the owner, for euthanasia services with a request that the animal’s body be returned to them, following euthanasia; owner is not present at the time of euthanasia.

Euthanasia Unattended By Owner/Communal Cremation - An animal is dropped off, by the owner, for euthanasia services with a request for a communal cremation (see “communal cremation” above); owner is not present at the time of euthanasia.

Euthanasia Unattended By Owner/Individual Cremation - An animal is dropped off, by the owner, for euthanasia services with a request for an individual cremation (see “individual cremation” above); owner is not present at the time of euthanasia.

Paws of Remembrance – this service gives pet parents a lasting remembrance of their pet by taking an impression of his or her foot into a clay-like material that later hardens into a plaque.

Columbarium – Our Columbarium is a peaceful and serene final resting place for the ashes of animals who have passed on. It is located on the east side of our Nina Mason Pulliam Campus for Compassion and is surrounded by a memorial park that invites pet parents to come and visit at any time.
