



## **BLINDNESS**

### **MEDICAL DISCLOSURE FOR BLINDNESS**

This pet is blind and unable to see their surroundings. The pet has adapted very well to lack of vision, but caution is recommended when introducing them to a new home until they become familiar with the new surroundings. Allowing the pet to hear your voice as you approach and before you pet him/her can help to avoid startling them. Do not leave the pet on an elevated surface where they may fall (ex. on top of couch, bed, table), near a pool area where they could drown, etc. All follow-up care will need to be done at the owner's veterinarian and at the owner's expense.
