This pet was diagnosed with Canine Distemper. Distemper is a virus that can cause mild to severe respiratory, gastrointestinal, and neurological signs. It is highly contagious to other dogs, especially those who are still puppies, unvaccinated, and immunocompromised. This pet was provided supportive care and is no longer showing any clinical signs. Re-testing has been performed, and the pet now tests negative for the virus. The pet is not currently showing any neurological signs, but there are some cases that may develop neurological issues later in life. All follow-up care will need to be done with the owner's veterinarian and at the owner's expense.
