



HISTORY OF SEIZURES

MEDICAL DISCLOSURE FOR HISTORY OF SEIZURES

This pet was reported to potentially have had seizures in the past. No seizures were observed during their time at the Arizona Humane Society, but there is a chance that more could occur in the future. Seizures may be caused by an infection, toxicity, epilepsy, organ dysfunction, or other causes. This pet had normal bloodwork results and tested negative for Valley Fever while at the shelter. The cause of this pet's seizures has not been determined. Further diagnostics will be required with the owner's veterinarian to determine the best form of treatment. Pets with ongoing seizures will likely need to stay on lifelong anti-seizure medication. All follow-up care will need to be done at the owner's veterinarian and at the owner's expense.
