

PARAPHIMOSIS MEDICAL DISCLOSURE FOR PARAPHIMOSIS

This pet came to us with paraphimosis, which is when the penis is not covered entirely by the prepuce (the sheath of skin surrounding the penis). It appears that this pet has lived with this condition for a majority of his life. Some animals end up having surgery because the exposure to air or licking causes damage to the penis. This pet had a cosmetic surgery to try and keep the penis within the prepuce. There is a chance of recurrence after this surgery, which may or may not require surgery in the future. All follow-up care will need to be done at the owner's veterinarian and at the owner's expense.
